### Legislative Days Tallahassee



Islands situated along the southern edge of Kings Bay in Crystal River, FL, cover roughly 33.2 acres. The Shoreline Restoration project for these marsh islands focuses on revitalization through the installation of nearshore wave breaks, strategic sediment placement, and the restoration of marsh plants and seagrass. These efforts aim to enhance elevation and mitigate future losses.



### Legislative Days Tallahassee

Save Crystal River aims to restore and protect the area's waterways for future generations through a science-driven approach. Key initiatives include:

- **Algae Removal:** Targeting invasive Lyngbya algae to improve water clarity.
- **Seagrass Restoration:** Replanting native seagrass meadows to enhance marine life and ecosystem health.
- **Spring System Revitalization:** Restoring natural spring flows by removing accumulated sand, Lyngbya, and debris from spring vents caused by erosion and nutrient excess.
